FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

Bowl 3 games per squad. Two squads to try to qualify for bracket.

Bowl three game qualifier. Can enter both squads. Can only qualify once for the bracket at each event.

Scratch bowling. No handicap

Top eight boys and eight girls from each squad will advance to the bracket finals.

This tournament is open to student athletes who are currently attending a Public or Private <u>Kansas</u> High School, a Home School equivalent, or graduated from a Kansas High School in May of 2025. If you are entering a Kansas High School or equivalent as a freshmen this fall, that is also permitted for entry to the tournament. All entrants must be USBC Youth sanctioned.

A school I.D. or other proof of attendance will be required to participate in tournament.

Added Prize Money \$2,600 per Division

Estimated Prize fund payout based on 30 Entries for Division

1st Place: \$1200 2nd Place: \$610 3rd & 4th Place: \$300 5th - 8th Place \$200

9th - 16th Place: \$130 TOTAL = \$4,250*

* More entries will result in a higher payout

INFORMATION

- 1. This tournament is certified and governed by all USBC Rules & Regulations.
- 2. This tournament is open to student athletes who are currently attending a Public or Private <u>Kansas</u> High School, a Home School equivalent, or graduated from a Kansas High School in May of 2025. If you are entering a Kansas High School or equivalent as a freshmen this fall, that is also permitted for entry to the tournament. All entrants must be USBC Youth sanctioned. A school I.D. or other proof of attendance will be required to participate in tournament.
- 3. This is a scratch event. No handicap.
- 4. There will be a separate division for boys and girls. Payout is the based on the entries for that division.
- 5. Multiple entries are allowed. You can only qualify once for the bracket for each tournament.
- 6. Entry fee is **\$75** per person, per squad. Squads are 10 AM & 1 PM. Announcements and practice will start at 9:45 AM & 12:45 PM respectively.
- 7. Check-in time will begin one hour before each squad.
- 8. Entry Fee Break down: \$20 Lineage, \$55 prize fund. \$5,200 is added from expiring SMART Funds and will be split equally between boys and girls divisions.
- 9. Any entrant that is late will be allowed to start bowling as long as 5 frames of the 1st game of qualifying hasn't been completed. If they arrive later than what is stated above, they will be disqualified from the tournament. No refund will be given.
- 10. Deadline for entering the tournament is Saturday, July 19th @ 5 PM.
- 11. This tournament will follow USBC Rule 301b. Bowlers are not allowed to wear hats, play arcade games, use tobacco products, use foul language or gestures. They cannot wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, or an illegal substance. Bowlers violating this rule will be given one warning and then will be removed from the tournament & bowling center.
- 12. Results will be posted on the center's website and Facebook.
- 13. All entries will be processed through the center's reservation system. No checks or cash allowed.
- 14. If a squad doesn't fill up, previous entrants may re-enter at that time by paying with a credit card or cash. No checks will be accepted.

ADDENDUM

Qualifying for the 16 person bracket:

- 1) If you bowl the morning or afternoon squad and place in the top 8 of your division in that squad, you will be seeded into the bracket with that score.
- 2) If you qualify for the morning squad and decide to bowl in the afternoon squad the following rules apply:
 - A) If your afternoon score places you in the top eight of that squad and results in a higher seeding in the bracket, we will use that score.
 - B) If you afternoon score does not place you in the top eight of that squad, the afternoon scores will not be used.
 - C) If your afternoon scores place you in the top eight of that squad, but do not result in a higher seeding in the bracket, we will not use that score.
- 3) If your score from morning squad is not in the top eight, you have two options.
 - A) You can choose not bowl the afternoon squad.
 - 1. If someone else bowls both squads and their afternoon scores move them up in the bracket from their morning scores, then we will move the next person up the finish list from the morning squad.
 - B) You can bowl the afternoon squad and try to improve your finish position.
- 4) After both squads have finished and the top 8 from each squad have been identified for the bracket, there will be a 10 minute warmup session before the 1st round of the bracket is started. After the 1st round, no practice between bracket matches.
